- **Campaign Performance Evaluation:** With limited direction, assess campaign effectiveness, identify areas for improvement, and track complex key metrics including click through, engagement, and conversion rates, offering expert advice on future improvements.
- **Market Research:** Conduct research on competitor strategies, market trends, and member behaviour to inform future campaign development.
- **Insight Generation:** Deliver data-driven insights coupled with learnt knowledge through previous experience to optimize marketing efforts, improve member engagement, identify target member segments that would benefit from engagement and increase Return of Investment (ROI) to Super SA of spend on campaigns.
- **Collaboration:** Work closely with the Marketing, Chief Strategy Officer and Product teams and other key stakeholders to translate insights into actionable recommendations and campaign plans.
