Government, Constitutional and Administrative Law

Provide advice and representation to statutory authorities responsible for regulating teachers, health practitioners and other professionals. Counsel in this section prosecute disciplinary matters in various boards and tribunals.

Commercial and Property

Undertake the full breadth of commercial and property law, including on the State's major projects.



Civil Litigation

Provide legal services to government and statutory authorities in a wide range of civil and commercial proceedings, coronial inquiries and Royal Commissions.

Compulsory Acquisition

Provide advice and representation for acquisition of land required for a public purpose on behalf of the State.



Coronial, Asbestos and Medical Negligence

Provide advice and representation to government agencies and employees in coronial investigations and inquests and claim management with SAFA for negligent medical treatment.



Child Protection

Represent the Department for Child Protection in the Youth Court and Family Court, to protect children at serious risk from physical, sexual, and/or emotional abuse.

Employment Law

Provide advice and represent Ministers and agencies on matters under the Return to Work Act, Public Sector Act, Fair Work Act and awards, agreements and other legislation, such as the ICAC Act and Equal Opportunity Act.



Environment and Planning

Provide advice and representation in prosecuting environmental, fisheries, statutory offences, and in planning and environmental civil matters.

Prosecution

Provide advice and counsel for trial for government departments and statutory authorities in prosecution cases (i.e. industrial safety, consumer affairs, workers compensation fraud etc.)

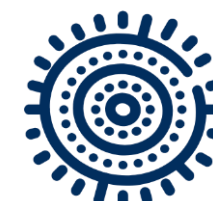


Victims of Crime

Assess and pay compensation to victims of crime, undertake recovery from offenders and provide advice to the Attorney-General.

Native Title and Aboriginal Heritage

Provide native title and Aboriginal legal advice and represent the State, including to resolve native title claims.
